### High Definition Video Conferencing by KTH based HDviaOSN: **Top quality at the lowest possible cost**

**Stockholm, Sweden, 15th October 2009.** The HDVC project presents a new video conferencing experience with the motto: “Save time and money, improve productivity and reduce carbon foot prints by traveling less”. It is a SIP based high definition video conferencing system, equal in quality to any similar product on the market but to unmatched price performances.

HDVC is a division of the KTH based HDviaOSN, a three folded project that works to provide a 10 GE optical network over dark fiber, create viable business plans and provide the open source high definition video conferencing for educational and research institutes.

HDVC has incorporated open source software, while adopting industry standards with off the shelf hardware components, to build a low cost, high performance and state of the art solution. The major aim is to provide high definition video conferencing to medical institutes. However, the flexibility of the system makes it usable for any customer as it meets a wide range of demands of bandwidth, encoding schemes and variant capturing card options.
